

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

FLEMINGTON TENNIS CLUB

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned do hereby associate themselves into a corporation under and by virtue of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes and the several supplements thereto and acts amendatory thereof.

I. The name of the corporation is FLEMINGTON TENNIS CLUB.

II. The purposes for which this corporation is formed is to provide facilities for and encourage the development of tennis as a healthful, educational and recreational activity in Hunterdon County; and to further said purposes the corporation shall have power to:

- a. Have perpetual succession by its corporate name;
- b. Sue and be sued, complain and defend in any court;
- c. Make and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;
- d. Choose such officers, members and agents as the business of the corporation may require;
- e. Make by-laws for the management of its property and the regulation of its affairs, which by-laws may contain provisions empowering any absent member entitled to vote at any meeting of the members of the corporation to be represented and vote at any such meeting by proxy authorized in writing, and said by-laws may prescribe the qualifications of such proxies and the form of the written authorization, but no such written authorization shall be valid after such date;
- f. Contract and be contracted with;
- g. Take and hold by lease, gift, purchase, grant, devise or bequest any property, real or personal, necessary or desirable for attaining the objects and carrying into effect the purpose of the corporation, subject, however, to any alteration or modification hereafter made by general law as to the amount of real and personal property to be held by the corporation;
